



## GDPR Compliance Statement

R Earsman recognises the significance of its GDPR compliance obligations in respect of both data protection and information security. We have always taken data security and privacy seriously and believe that GDPR is a good step forward for clarifying and enabling individual privacy rights.

The GDPR 2018 is a new data protection law across the European Economic Area (EEA) and the UK that replaces the Data Protection Act 1998 (PDA). The GDPR applies to any personal data, defines as *“any information relating to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified in particular by reference to an identifier”*, and is enforced by the Information Commissioner’s Officer (ICO). It effectively sets a new landscape for data protection regulation across the EEA.

R Earsman will as a minimum comply with all GDPR requirements.

We will only use personal information if we have a lawful reason to do this in the process of administering accounts and to provide products and services that have been requested from us.
